- (3) Each pallet is individually tested and the test results are reported on the Certificate of Analysis for that specific pallet.
- (4) Due to test equipment limitations, particle size greater than 300 microns are not measured. However, per the specification above any such particles must meet the maximum limitation for 45 micron wet screen retain. If larger particle (even in small amounts) could present a problem to the user's application or equipment, it is recommended that this material be tested prior to use.
